Companies and economies worldwide struggle with the consequences of a mismatch between training and labor market requirements. They suffer from a poorly trained workers, high unemployment rates and gaining a foothold in value chains.

Switzerland's public-private partnership for vocational and professional education and training (VPET) is a key factor for the country's economic success and low unemployment. It leads to labour market relevant skills and recognized qualifications. The system's success depends heavily on the involvement of private labor market organisations and companies. The event will shed light on how SkillSonics successfully addresses these challenges based on Swiss methodologies and IFC's plans in vocational training for the Western Balkans.
